Friday, April 15th :

Their first game was a hard fought 4-3 loss against the Jr Moose. The Moose got on the board first in the first period but defenseman, **Brett Adnum** scored shortly afterwards, unassisted. **John Henrion** scored again less than a minute later with helpers from **Zach Dahrooge** and **Cody Eakin**. The Moose finished up the first period with two more goals to lead 3-2. **James Henry** was the only scorer in the second period to tie things up 3-3. He had assists from **Roo Adams** and **Adnum**. His goal was a PPG. The Moose would get the lone score in the third to win the game 4-3.

The second game of the day was against the Regional Express. This game was a high scorer with the Junior Bruins winning 8-5. The first two goals were unassisted goals by **Eakin** and **Henry**. **Dahrooge** got the next two with assists from **Eakin** and **Adnum** on his first, and **Henry** and **Pierre-Erik Martell** on his second. **Henrion** then scored a PPG from **Cody Learned**. **Matt Westcott** scored the sixth and the GWG with the helper from **Mike Borge**. **Borge** then scored his own from **Dahrooge**. **Learned** would end the scoring with an empty netter with assists from **Adams** and **Henry**.

Friday, April 29th:
