## Happy New Year!

*The Junior Bruins staff hopes everyone had a safe and happy New Year. Now that the two-week break is over the teams are back at the rinks and looking at a very busy couple of months.*

### Overview:

#### Juniors

The Junior team continues to lead in the EJHL both in the Northern division and overall. Their current record is 39-9-4. The EJHL has welcomed Pointstreak as their statistical support recorder. (An overview of Pointstreak can be found on page 4 ).

Since the Juniors have returned from their break they are 10-2 with a league loss to Apple Core. With a great New Year start, on January 8<sup>th</sup> they beat the Harbor Wolves 5-1. **Bobby Butler** scored the game winning goal. **Cody Wild, Garrett Peters, Cody Carlson** and **Pat Kimball** also scored. **Ryan Ginand** and **Jim Driscoll** provided the team with dual assists. **Nevin Hamilton** would secure the win with a 95% save percentage. The following day would continue on the same path with a 6-2 win over the Valley Jr Warriors. **Cody Carlson (pictured)** got an unassisted game winner.

This would be **Cody's** second goal of the game and third on the weekend. **Ryan Ginand** had his 7<sup>th</sup> power play goal of the season. **Chris Rossi** was solid in net with 28 saves. On January 12<sup>th</sup>, the dynamic goaltending duo of



**Hamilton** and **Rossi** would shut out the Harbor Wolves 8-0. Both goalies are currently the top two in the EJHL. **Luke Jones** got the first goal which was the game winner with helpers from **Kory Falite** and **Garrett Peters**. **Ginand** and **Alex Berry** scored two each. **Cody Wild** scored his 7<sup>th</sup> PPG. His PPG was assisted by **Mike Luzzi** who had 3 total in the game.

They had a slow start and were behind the entire game until the third period when they scored 4 unanswered goals. **Bobby Butler** came out to tie the game 39 seconds into the 3<sup>rd</sup> period with assists from **Kimball** and **Hamilton**. **Chris Donovan** clinched the win 1 minute 3 seconds after **Butler's** goal. **Hamilton** made sure none of the 8 shots in the 3<sup>rd</sup> period would get by. **Ginand** put two more in leaving us scratching our heads except for **Mike Yandle** (Bruins assistant coach). **Mike** came out of the locker room before the third period certain the team would win the game 5-3. 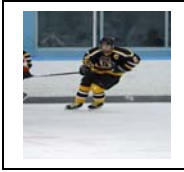

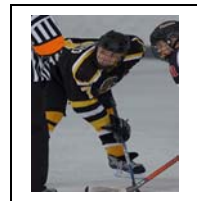

The lead wasn't for long, when less than 4 minutes later CD tied the game at 3. The third and 'unusual' period came with equal shots on net by both teams. With only 2 ½ minutes left in the game CD scored. One minute later **Butler** would pass to **Peters** who made the shot which rebounded off of **Ginand's** chest finding the back of the net. The game was tied with a little more than a minute when the puck ended on a CD player's stick ending up in the CD's net. **Ginand** would get credit for the goal and the game winner.

The Midget AAA's are also having a great start after break. They have won 7 of their first 9 games. On January 7<sup>th</sup> they had an opportunity to play against the Druzhba team from Russia. 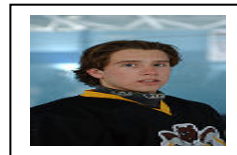
## INJURIES:

Matt was voted the teams Unsung Hero as a senior.

Pointstreak is a recording mechanism that keeps the goals, penalties, power plays, penalty kills, shots on net, and goals per period. This information is then relayed to their website at [www.pointstreak.com](http://www.pointstreak.com) as soon as the data is submitted to them. The website then provides the league standings, individual team stats, league leaders, and game re-caps. Pointstreak is utilized nationwide. The Beantown Summer Classic and Prospects Tournament use pointstreak.
