Juniors

The Juniors started the month on the 1st with a 5-2 win against the NH Monarchs. The Monarchs got the first goal. **Topher Bevis** tied it up with an unassisted PPG with only 13 seconds remaining in the first. **Ryan Ginand** scored early in the second with helpers from **Cody Carlson** and **Cody Wild**. Two minutes later **Alex Berry** got a PPG assisted by **Ginand** and **Wild**. **Berry's** goal would be the GWG. The Monarchs scored at the end of the second keeping close at 3-2. Half way through the third **Evan MackIntosh** passed to **Garrett Peters** giving the Bruins a 4-2 lead. **Kory Falite** got the 5th and final unassisted goal.

March 4th, the Bruins found their scoring touch to beat the Walpole Stars 7-6. **Butler** would get the B's on the board first with assists from **Falite** and **Berry**. **Mike Harr** got the second goal from **Luzzi** and **Carlson**. Walpole came back with two goals and the B's retaliated with three more from **Russell** and two from **Falite**. **Falite** and **Butler** had the assist on **Russell's** goal. **Berry** and **Wild** had assists to **Falite's** first goal which was a PPG. **Butler** and **Bevis** had the other assists. Walpole came back strong and scored two more, then so would the Bruins, this time **Butler** got two, the first being a PPG with assists from **Russell** and **Bevis**. **Butler's** second goal was unassisted which would end up being the GWG because the Stars scored two more at the end leaving

the final score 7-6.

On March 5th, the Bruins had an opportunity to play against the USA-18 team at Belmont Hill. There were over 300 people in attendance. The Bruins played a heartfelt battle and even with 27 shots on net **Falite** would be the sole scorer with helpers from **Bobby Butler** and **Casey Russell**. The game ended with a 5-1 loss.

A week later on the 12th, the Bruins lost to the Huskies 3-2 in their final season game. **Carlson** and **Berry** had the two goals. **Harr**, **Wild**, **Bevis**, and **Chris Donovan** would all get one helper.

A few days later on the 16th, the Bruins had their first game in the EJHL Playoffs and tied the Falcons 1-1. **Peters** scored the tying goal with assists from **Ginand** and **Harr**. **Hamilton** was strong in net making 36 saves. On the 18th, the Bruins went into OT with the Falcons to win 4-3.

Butler had the GWG. **Falite** and **Wild** had the helpers. **Pat Kimball**, who just returned from an injury had scored first from **Donovan**. The Falcons then took the lead with two PPG goals. A few minutes later, **Peters** scored with assists from **Luke Jones** and **Berry**. The second period ended 2-2. Less than a minute into the third period the Falcons scored. **Ginand** from **Russell** and **Wild** tied it up midway into the third. The goaltenders would not allow another goal to end the game in regulation 3-3. The Bruins responded quickly in OT. **Wild** to **Falite** with an unbelievable pass to **Butler** would win the game and send them to the semi finals.

The semi finals against the Walpole Stars were held on the 20th. **Hamilton** earned the shut out making 37 saves! The game was scoreless after the first period. **Jimmy Driscoll** scored the first goal which was a PPG and the GWG with helpers from **Ginand** and **Wild**. Four minutes later, **Donovan** scored from **Matt Fitzgibbons** and **Bevis**. The third period remained scoreless leaving the final score 2-0. The Bruins advanced to the finals to play the NH Monarchs. On the 22nd, the Bruins would play the Monarchs who just missed the division title by one point. The Monarchs came out early. Two minutes into the first they scored on a PPG. The Bruins would have their opportunity for a PPG mid way through the first period and **Falite** would score from **Peters** and **Russell**. The first period ended 1-1. The Bruins were the ones to come on strong in the second period with another PPG scored by **Berry** from **Ginand** and **Wild**. Two minutes later,

Donovan increased the lead with helpers from **Kimball** and **Fitzgibbons**. With under five minutes left in the third, the Monarchs scored on another PPG to end the second period with the Bruins leading 3-2. The Monarchs scored early in the third to tie the game 3-3 looking like it could be another OT game but with a minute left in the third, **Luke Jones** from **Ginand** and **Harr** would win the game and the EJHL Championships!!

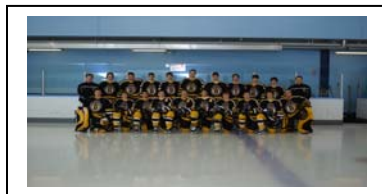

The Midget AAA's concluded their season winning the EMJHL Regular Season



Campionship and advancing to the EMJHL playoff title game for the third straight year. They won the 2004 EMJHL Playoff title a year ago.

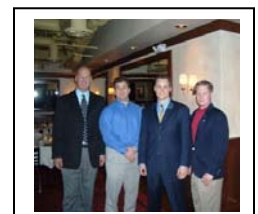
On March 5th and 6th the Midget AAA's made their last trip of the season to Philly, as well as play their last regular season games before playoffs. On the 5th they walked away with a 6-3 win. **Chris Webb** would start it off with a PPG

from **Steve Bergin** and **John Henrion**. This was **Steve Bergin's** first game back after his wrist injury. The second goal was also a PPG by **Edwin Shea** with helpers from **Joe Lavin** and **Nathan Lavner**. **Shea** would score again with an assist from **Cody Warila** then **Henrion** scored the fourth and the GWG before Philly even got on the board. **Evan MackIntosh** scored early in the third from **Lavin** and **Steve Moses**. **Mike Burke** got the final goal with Justin **Alonzo** getting the assist. **Nathan Kudla** was strong in net with 1 GA for the first two periods and made the necessary stops to clear the path for **Justin Gates** who secured the win with 12 saves in the third period.

The next day the score would not be in favor of the B's. The AAA'ers did not score their first and only goal until late into the second period. **Warila** scored a PPG with an assist from **Phil Ginand** and **Bergin** but that goal was not enough as the Flyers, who were preparing for Midget Nationals, got the best of the black and gold on Sunday morning.

Earning the EMJHL division title gained them a buy in the first round of playoffs. Their semi final game would be against the Portland Pirates. The pirates scored a big upset of the #3 seed LI Gulls in the quarterfinals. The Midget AAA's had a scoring frenzy to overcome the Pirates 9-1. **Lavner** scored first from **Bergin**. **Ginand** got the second goal which would be the GWG, with assists from **Schuster** and **MackIntosh**. Then the last goal in the first period was a PPG from **Moses**, **Mike Cichy** had the assist. **Schuster** started the second period with a PPG from **Shea** and **MackIntosh**. **Alonzo** scored next from **Moses**. The Pirates then got their only goal midway through the second period. Shortly thereafter **Moses** and **Cichy** scored the 6th and 7th goals. **Shea** assisted **Moses**, and **Webb** and **Warila** assisted **Cichy**. **Warila** then scored a PPG of his own from **Cichy** and **Webb**, who also assisted on the final goal from **Mike Burke**.

The Midget AAA's found themselves in the title game once again for the third year in row against the Little Bruins at the Hart Center on the campus of Holy Cross. The Midget AAA'ers got on the board first seven minutes into the first period on a beautiful back and forth passing effort from **Ginand** and **Schuster**. **Schuster** would get the goal. Less than two minutes later, the Little B's would even it up. One more goal was scored in the first by the Little B's. The Little B's would continue their momentum and scored 3 minutes into the second period. The AAA'ers continued to pummel the net of **Justin Gates**, and finally broke through one more time with an unassisted goal from **Mike Cichy**. The Little B's scored one more after that to win the Championships 4-2.

Franklin, Glass, Burrows, Brosnihan, White and Pallos had solid performances in the playoffs. **Josh Franklin** of Nobles had two goals, **Andrew Glass** assisted on his first. **Josh Burrows** got a helper on Nobles' first goal. **Pat Brosnihan** got Worcester Academy's GWG in the quarterfinals against Kent's Hill. **Justin Pallos** led St Mark's in a 6-2 win over Brunswick. **Alan Dionne, Tommy Montiero** and **Stephen Morra** all played key roles in their LaSalle team racing the RI State Champion series.

After their playoffs the Little B's would have to change gears and uniforms to play in the EMJHL playoffs. Their first game was against the NE Jr Falcons.
