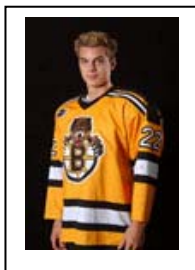
Junior Bruins Teams

~JUNIORS~

Another close game but the B's prevailed with a 6-5 win. Butler had 2goals and 2 assists. Kory Falite offered 1 goal with 3 assists. On the 7th, the B's squeaked by the BayState Breakers with a 4-3 win. Chris Rossi had 27 saves. Nick DeCroo had the game winner. Three days later they met up with the Breakers again with another close win, 5-4 in OT. Pat Kimball scored the GWG!

On the 15th they tied NH Jr Monarchs 1-1. DeCroo had the lone goal which was a PPG, and Rossi had 37 saves. On the 22nd the B's took a loss to the NJ Hitmen, 5-3. Driscoll, Donovan and Carls on had the goals for the B's. The following weekend the Juniors traveled to NY. The Juniors took another loss to Syracuse, 6-5. Butler, Falite, DeCroo, Kimball and Pallos all had singletons. They would recover the next day to beat Syracuse 7-6 in OT. Solomon had two goals and 1 assist. He had the GWG in OT. 2006 teams forming

FRAMINGHAM, MA-The Junior Bruins have begun the process of putting together their 2006 AAA tournament teams. Junior Bruins coaches have begun to "hit the rinks" to evaluate talent. Tryout dates have also been set up (probably for late December) for those players who the Bruins do not get a chance to see.

If you are a local player or live out of our immediate area and are interested in playing for the Junior Bruins please send Chris Masters an email and include the following:

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do you select your teams?

There are three ways we select players for our teams.

1. Game Evaluations-Junior Bruins coaches will go to games throughout the fall and winter to evaluate players. They generally only get to see EHF games.

2. Tryouts-In 2004 we had our first "open" tryouts in December and selected players from there as well as our game evaluations. There are so many leagues (EHF, MBHL, Selects, etc.) it need to continue to see him play more.

c) In some cases players will be notified that there will not be a spot for them with us this season.

Our 2005 tryouts are tentatively that we are no longer able to get to the rinks and see every team play and there are too many good players that we miss. Another reason for our tryouts is that we may only see a team play once and a player could have missed that game, been sick or had an off day. The tryouts allow players we have never seen as well as players we may have seen to get a second or third evaluation. Our tryouts are not like most where players are notified if they are selected or "cut". After our tryouts we will do one of the following:

- a) Offer a player a spot on our team.
 - b) Let a player know that we will put his team on our scouting schedule because we liked what we saw planned for late December (during Christmas school vacation).
3. Recommendations-We will also (particularly for players that live out of our area that we will never be able to see and cannot make tryouts) take

Selection Process cont'd....

When will your rosters be finalized?

The process of selecting players and finalizing team rosters takes 5-6 months. The process usually starts in November and continues into the late winter. Last season our teams were not fully selected till March. The same should be expected this year. We will start to select players through December and then will hold tryouts. We will select players from tryouts and continue to evaluate players in games through January, February and March.

How many tournaments do you go to?

The number of tournaments an age group goes to varies. Most teams will go to three tournaments (usually a tournament in Toronto, Montreal and one locally). Some age groups will do more depending on the schedule and interest level.

How many players do you bring to each tournament?

This varies on the age and period length of games at that tournament. At the younger ages (U-12) we will carry 8 forwards, 5 defensemen and 2 goalies. There are tournaments when the period lengths are 15 or 17 minutes and if that is the case we will bring 9 forwards, 6 defensemen and 2 goalies. At the older ages (12 and older) we will carry 9 forwards, 6 defensemen and 2 goalies. At the oldest age levels (16-20 year olds) we may carry 4 lines

How do you manage playing time?

We feel that every player we invite is a good one and deserves to play. We "roll the lines" and try to give each player an equal amount of ice time. However, the last five minutes of a game and overtime are "coaches time" and he has the latitude to "shorten" the bench and play those he feels gives the team the best chance to win. The same can be said for the play-off rounds.
