The new Empire Jr B team has had a great start of the season! As of the end of September their record was 8-3-3.

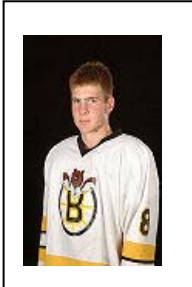

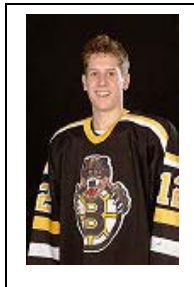
