The Juniors started things off on the 4th of February with a 5-1 win over BWB. Chris Donovan had the GWG. Jon Lareau, Matt Fitzgibbons, Kory Falite and Kyle Solomon all had goals. Falite and Matt Kronk had two assists. Chris Rossi had 23 saves on the game. Rossi earned a shut out the next day with a 3-0 win over Walpole Stars. He had 29 saves. Cody Carlson, Bobby Butler and Falite all had goals.

The following weekend the B's enjoyed it off. Then they would encounter a 3 game stretch. On 2/17 another shut out for Rossi, 5-0. Nathan Lavner scored the first which was the GWG. Edwin Shea and Justin Pallos both had PPG's and Falite had one. Ben Rosen had two assists. The 18th the Bruins battled the Hitmen to a 5-2 win. Carlson had a hat trick, the GWG and a PPG. Falite and Pat Kimball had the other two goals. Fitzgibbons had two helpers. The final of the three games was a disappointing loss to the Selects, 3-1. Butler had the lone goal for the B's.

Moses had another hat trick Cichy and Paul Nannicelli had the other two goals. On 2/6 they had an 8-4 win over Salem. Moses had two and Alonzo, Dionne, Henrion, Boehm, Sullivan and Zarbo all had singletons.

The next weekend the high scoring continued with a 7-3 win over NE Jr Huskies. Moses had yet another hat trick, his third in a week. Craig Segien had two and White and Nannicelli had the other two. 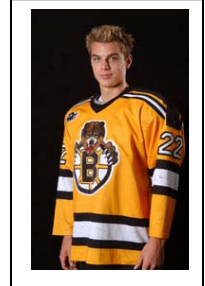
College Commitment

Pat is from Framingham, MA. He has 21 goals, 28 assists with 49 points and is +13. He has played in 53 games so far this season.

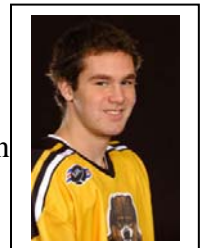
