Defense Camp

Peter and Chris Masters offer a camp directed at defensive play. While it is called a Defensemen Camp, it is not limited to defensemen only. We have a camper breakdown that is typically 60% defensemen/40% forwards. It is imperative for a forward to be able to play defense. You never know when your player might be moved to defense.

This camp features limited enrollment and Division 1 and pro players as instructors. The focus is on defensive skills such as "gap" control, body checking, play in front of the net, break outs, and communication skills on ice. Your player will also be taught and have work done on improving offensive skills such as shooting, passing, and, most importantly, jumping into the play. The main focus will be on "one on one" play. As your player climbs the ladder in the hockey world, being able to handle a "one on one" is essential.

Too often young defensemen get into the habit of playing "defense" only. He/she never rushes the puck and rarely considers themselves a valuable part of the offense. It is our belief that to become a great defenseman you need to know not only how to play defense, but also when to become part of the offense! So, you will spend a good amount of time handling pucks and learning how to contribute offensively as a defenseman. Your player will be pushed, corrected, and always be moving.

Powerskating Camp

Bill Riga directs this camp aimed to make all players, more efficient and powerful skaters in just 5 short days.

This camp features limited enrollment and Division 1 and pro players as instructors. The focus is on the stride itself, edge work and control, crossovers, starts, stops and backwards skating. It will completely re-tool a player's skating and make a big difference in a short amount of time.

Too often, players like to work solely on stick skills including shooting and passing skills. While these are worthwhile and important, the skating is neglected. Nothing will make you struggle more as player than poor skating. The skills taught in this camp are the same taught to Division I and professional hockey players taught in a way that can relate to the younger player. Do not miss this great opportunity!!

Conte earns high marks in rookie campaign

**Hitmen alumni earns rookie of the
year/defensive player of the year
honors**

State College, PA - Growing up in New Jersey, John Conte, was a big fish in a small pond, literally. The 6'2" defenseman had all the tools and showed them annually cementing himself on the Atlantic district 86 festival team, earning high school all conference honors and becoming one of the most imposing defensemen in the EJHL for two seasons. When he made the choice to attend Penn State University everyone knew he would continue to grow not only as a player, but as a person.

In just his first season at Penn State, Conte did not disappoint. The Mahwah, NJ native earned the Joe Battista Defensive Player of the Year award, as well as the rookie of the year honor. Finishing the season with a +26 rating, Conte was also noticed by the AHCA, as he was nominated ACHA rookie of the year and ACHA all-american.

"I always knew he had it in him," commented coach Harris. "I worked with the defense the last couple of years, and although not very flashy John rarely made any mistakes. I know he worked extremely hard in the off season, and was prepared to step right into the Penn State program." Harris went on to say, "I am very proud of what John has accomplished, and look forward to big things out of him in the future."
